## **IMPORTING THE RUBRIC**

- 1. Download and save the *ImportThisRubric.zip* file.
- 2. Log in to http://learn.uark.edu and go to the course where you want the rubric to be imported.
- 3. Click the **Course Tools** menu and locate click on **Rubrics** in the tool list.







5. Click the Browse My Computer button. Select the file (ImportThisRubric.zip) and click Open.



6. Click the **Submit** button.



7. The new rubric will appear in the **Rubrics** list.



## ATTACHING THE RUBRIC TO A GRADED DISCUSSION

- 1. Create a discussion forum to be graded (or click the option button for an existing forum and select Edit).
- Under Forum Settings (at the bottom) select "Grade Discussion Forum: Points possible:" and enter point value. (Note: This rubric is based on a 10 point assignment but may be modified in the Rubrics section of Course Tools in the Control Panel)
